Invite each family member to ponder what gift they would give Jesus. Have them consider giving different gifts from the heart: being more kind to a family member, less fighting, helping without being asked, including others who feel left out.



Show the print 'What Gift Can I Give' and read the poem. Invite your family to write down one gift they will be giving Jesus during the year. Place the these slips in the paper origami boxes which they will make as part of Day 10's activity.


