**9** Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

**10** Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.



open you the windows of heaven,


**AND POUR YOU OUT A BLESSING, THAT THERE

## Malachi 4:5-6

To make flashcards cut along the dotted lines. Fold each strip in half so the scripture reference is on one side and the scripture text is on the other. Glue shut. You can laminate these or use wide packing tape to “laminare” both sides.

Suggestions for use:

1. Turn cards so all scripture references are face up and spread around on the table. Call out a key phrase. The youth race to put their finger on the right scripture reference. The first to correctly point to the card keeps the card. The student with the most cards ‘wins.’ May

also play in teams with a team sending forward a new representative each time.

2. Play as above only turn cards so the scripture text is facing up. Call out a scripture reference. First person or team to point to the correct text ‘wins.’

3. Put either text or scripture reference facing up. Say a basic doctrine. First person that points to a card that falls under that basic doctrine keeps the card. This is great to let students explain how they feel a certain scripture teaches a basic doctrine. You might be surprised at their insights!
